Past Commodore Vince Druding to spoke at our October Meeting

Past Commodore Vince Druding gave a presentation at the October Membership meeting about how to care for a heart attack victim aboard a boat. Captain Vince explained the symptoms to look for in case of a heart attack. He told us that men and women can have different symptoms and that women may not have the classic pain down the left arm. Instead they may have pain in their neck, upset stomach or pain in the jaw among others. Severe chest pain is always something to take seriously. If you do have symptoms don't try to drive yourself to the hospital, call an ambulance. If you are on the water and start feeling like you might be having a heart attack it is important to get to safety as fast as you can. Call ahead to meet emergency responders at the closest dock. No matter if you are on land or water having aspirin close by and taking one at the onset of symptoms may save your life.


